The Gold Star Chapter of the Leathernecks Nation MC supports Gold Star families. Below is a description of what a "Gold Star" is:

Gold Star is a lapel pin issued to wives, mothers, fathers, children, and siblings who have lost their Soldier, Marine, Sailor, or Airman in combat.

In the past 40 years, it has been expanded to include those who died of a service connected disability and suicide.

The Gold Star lapel pin is a circular pin worn on the left breast with a purple background and a gold star in the medal.

The purple dates back to George Washington and the Purple Heart medal.

The Gold Star was introduced during Wilson's administration when service flags became popular.

Blue means a person from your home is on active duty; while, a gold star denotes someone from your home gave the ultimate sacrifice.
